**Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association** is a wholesale electric power supplier owned by the 44 electric cooperatives and public power districts that we serve. We generate and transport electricity to our member systems at 359 delivery points throughout a 250,000-square-mile service territory across Colorado, Nebraska, New Mexico and Wyoming. Together, the co-ops provide electricity and innovative energy solutions to nearly 600,000 member-consumer meters — a population of approximately 1.5 million people.

Based in the Denver-metro area, Tri-State is Colorado's second largest electric utility. Our 3,841-megawatt generation portfolio consists of a combination of owned baseload and peaking power plants that use coal and natural gas as their primary fuels, along with leased and contracted supplies of power featuring a significant hydroelectric allocation that is supported by emerging renewable resource technologies.

To deliver the electricity where it is needed, Tri-State owns, operates and maintains a 5,267-mile high-voltage transmission network throughout the four states, providing the necessary link between the generating stations and the distribution cooperatives' delivery systems.

As cooperatives, Tri-State and our member systems provide more than just reliable, affordable electric power. We also bring a long-standing commitment to the communities that we serve and continually strive to contribute to the economic vitality and quality of life in the West.
